CDFS Upgrade

A new SCSI/CDFS upgrade (CDFS 2,13) will be available shortly, This new upgrade allows Acorn SCSI cards (AKA31 and AKA32) to be used with the Acorn Multimedia Expansion unit, The new SCSI/CDFS upgrade should be ordered from your normal supplier, Product Code AKA34,

PocketFS and VProtect

Due to an incompatibility between PocketFS and early versions of VProtect, when you attempt to run! PocketFS the following message is displayed by PocketFS:

'Please quit PocketFS from the Icon Bar'

Pineapple Software have kindly agreed to modify VProtect to avoid the problem and a new version of VProtect can be obtained from them if you are experiencing this problem,

CS News Issue 17 Disc Contents.

This months Customer Service News Issue 17 Disc contains a new version of the !Printers application, The new version (0,34) is intended to improve printing on single floppy drive systems, The are also a number of other advantages to using the software

such as speed of loading, On the disc with the ! Printers application and !Scrap are two documentation files which will need to be read and understood to use the new !Printers Application.

Replacing Your Computer's Batteries.

Since 1986 Acorn has used CMOS RAM within its computers to hold various settings about how the machine is set up upon switch on,

The BBC Master 128 uses a set of three batteries shrink wrapped into a complete unit which plugs via *a* flying lead onto the motherboard (connector PL8), Acorn recommends that the batteries be replaced once every 12 months to ensure that the integrity of the CMOS RAM, The Acorn product code for the BBC Master 128 battery pack is ADT16, Only the Acorn part ADT16 should be used,

The Acorn 300 and 400 Series Archimedes computers were also fitted with batteries; the difference is that the batteries are just two standard AA-size alkaline batteries, *Do not use batteries with non-leakproof cells*. If they leak they may damage the inside of the computer, Again it is recommended the batteries are replaced once a year, Please refer to the User/Welcome guide supplied with the system for further details on dismantling the computer.

Technical Information

RISC OS 3 CMOS Problems

We have received a number of reports of systems not powering up correctly when fitted with a RISC OS 3 upgrade. We suspect this is due to rogue CMOS RAM settings which occurred while the system was used with RISC OS 2.

We strongly recommend that a 'DELETE power on' is performed before the RISC OS 2 upgrade is removed. This will ensure that CMOS RAM locations now used by RISC OS 3 are set correctly,

Panasonic KXP2124 Firmware incompatibility

We have become aware of an incompatibility between versions 'M124E' of the KXP2124 firmware and the RISC OS 3.1 printer manager,

ROMS marked with 'IC3 M124C' and 'IC M124F' ie, versions 'C' and 'F' of the firmware work correctly. The problem with revision 'E' of the firmware is that the printer appears to ignore all data from the parallel port. ie. it fails to print. The printer definition file used on the KXP2124 is Epson LQ860. Panasonic have requested that dealers contact them on their customers behalf for upgrades,

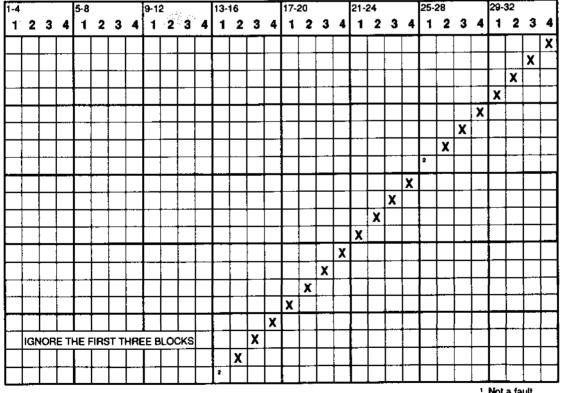

Power On Self Test Information

On the disc supplied with the Customer Service Issue 15 was the application note covering the Power On Self Test Diagnosis information, We have had a number of comments about the complexity of working out the meaning of the floppy drive flash codes and therefore we have produced the diagram below which hopefully will simplify the process,
