These developments are taking Acorn into exciting new areas of business. I am grateful for the commitment of our customers, other business partners and, last but not least, our employees without whom no business founded on the creation of intellectual property can succeed.

"New Era for Acorn" **ACORNUSER**

Predicting the death of Acorn as a computer manufacturer has been a popular pastime in the computer trade. Ever since 1985 its demise has been imminent, within the next two years the only home-grown computer manufacturer will be no more and for the last eleven years the pundits have been mistaken.

It's true that in ten years up to 1995 Acorn was diminishing slowly. The relentless onslaught of power advertising from the giants of the home and business computer industry against which Acorn could not compete took its toll.

Although Acorn had begun to carve small areas for itself within the major markets, the creation of the ARM chip and then ARM Ltd, followed by the development of the Set-top Box for interactive TV. It wasn't really enough.

By 1995, coincident with the arrival of the new boss, David Lee, it was quite clear that something had to be done. It was a painful situation and the remedies

were not without their own painful results.

Surprise

David Lee has referred to the creation of Xemplar, which has proved its commitment and value to both Apple and Acorn and invested heavily in future developments of RISC OS.

Then came the surprise explosion of the Internet, the set-top box developers were shocked out of the complacency of their predictions to find that the Internet, not interactive TV had become the next big thing. But Acorn were there already, and a suitably modified A7000 became the basis of their prototype to the giant US corporation Oracle which matched the design for the NetComputer.

Superb

In the UK Acorn is still viewed as that little education supplier and receives brickbats from the common press, yet overseas Acorn's image is utterly different. The view of the big corporations is

that Acorn is the company with superb hardware and software technology and the people to talk to if you want an alternative to Microsoft and Intel. And many companies do.

These changes to Acorn's image are beginning to make an impression on the British computer press and with the new NetStation consumer web-browser (for people who won't buy a computer) from NChannel a new era is beginning for Acorn.

Thrive

That Acorn will thrive is no longer in question as they have so many big partners outside of the UK that they cannot help but expand and develop. And each of the technical developments that Acorn produce for their customers is reflected in the products they bring to us, the dedicated users who have never ceased to have faith in what Acorn are capable of producing.

The future can be Acorn's after all.

StrongARM on Your Christmas Tree?

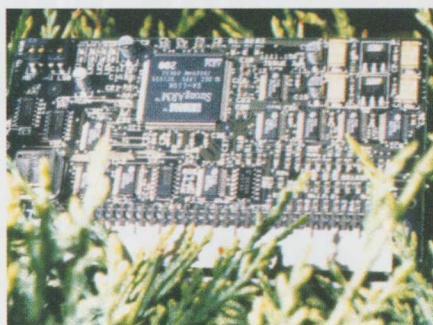
Visitors to Acorn World '96 will see the biggest range of new product introductions, demonstrations and seminars in the history of the event.

Primary, Secondary & Special Needs Seminars

The first day of Acorn World has an education bias, with a dedicated programme of seminars on IT in the classroom for children from pre-school age to secondary level. The seminars are each an hour long and will take place in the main demonstration Theatre on Level One

Speakers from Xemplar and experienced educational IT teachers will present seven hour-long topics at Acorn World, designed to address key issues surrounding the use of computers in the classroom:

10.30 - A School's IT Framework

primary/secondary.

Dick Wallin of Xemplar will explore the future for the many schools currently using RISC OS products, and describe the development of the 'XMPC' - the next generation of educational computers. The machine will deploy a StrongARM card in a MacOS reference platform, enabling schools to access the vast range of RISC OS software, and take advantage of the industry standard graphics, publishing and other specialised software available in MacOS format.

11.30 - IT in Special Needs

primary/secondary. In this session for both primary and secondary sectors, Paul Nuttall of SEM-ERC (previously Primary Co-ordinator for IT in Manchester LEA) will look at using Acorn computers with users who have special needs including those with physical and intellectual difficulties. The session will examine basic access to Acorn computers via keyboards, mouse alternatives, touch screens, switches and access software and review a range of suitable software.

12.30 - Managing IT Across the Curriculum

secondary. In this secondary schools' session, Alastair Wells, Head of IT at the Netherall School, Cambridge will examine strategies for managing all aspects of IT in schools. Curriculum mapping, IT policies, inset and assessment techniques, motivating colleagues and supporting special needs will be covered. Case studies will stimulate teachers to adapt and implement IT schemes of work in their own schools.

13.30 - StrongARM for the RISC PC

primary/secondary. Chris Cox of ART will describe how the new 200MHz StrongARM upgrade for the RISC PC, delivers such impressive performance gains and will relate this to use in education. He will explain how the separate instruction and data caches affect performance and the compatibility issues raised by this new design. The presentation will also cover the installation of a StrongARM into a RISC PC, and the new features included in the operating system release - RISC OS 3.7.

14.30 - Pre School IT

primary. This session by Paul Nuttall will look at a range of software for the nursery school. It will include basic cause and effect software, colour and shape recognition, sequencing and handwriting. The session will also look at a range of hardware that can be useful in helping younger children use the computer, such as touchscreens, mouse pens and concept keyboards.

15.30 - The Community Superhighway

primary,secondary. Alastair Wells' second session for primary and secondary schools will examine the need to expand the use of IT in schools, including multimedia authoring of Intranet, Internet and Interactive Television materials. Long-term development plans for incorporating the Superhighway in the school, home and community will be considered together with network solutions and the potential impact on staffing.

16.30 - Primary Networking

Alan Bennett of Xemplar will present this seminar on the use of simple networks for classroom teaching in primary schools. Networks can save time and resources, ease the problems of access to peripherals and manage a small school's resources to the greatest advantage.
