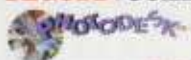

It's been a short year, even with the extra leap-century day, the time has just flown by but has anything really happened in the RISC OS world? There are a few people around, many with loud voices, who would have us believe that the end is nigh, I believe them as much as I would anyone wearing a sandwich board and wandering up and down the High Street. They can go into their local High Street store and buy a PC if they want to, but such people are a small loss. The death of the Acorn market has been predicted as being in "the next year" for so long now that I've given up even listening.

Resources help – of course they do – but without them you just have to be a little bit cleverer: bright ideas come from original thinkers and they don't come much more original than RISC OS people.

Rebuilding the market to a point of real viability is not going to be easy, but it is not impossible. What it requires is people working together, co-ordinated effort in the same direction – the one thing we cannot afford is internal bickering. This doesn't mean that companies cannot be in competition with one another; it does mean that the overriding factor in all decision making should be: Does this promote RISC OS, or damage it?

That way we can compete in the real world and get to a point where messages like this are completely unnecessary because we will be successful. This show reveals some exciting new hardware and some very nice new software. Enjoy!

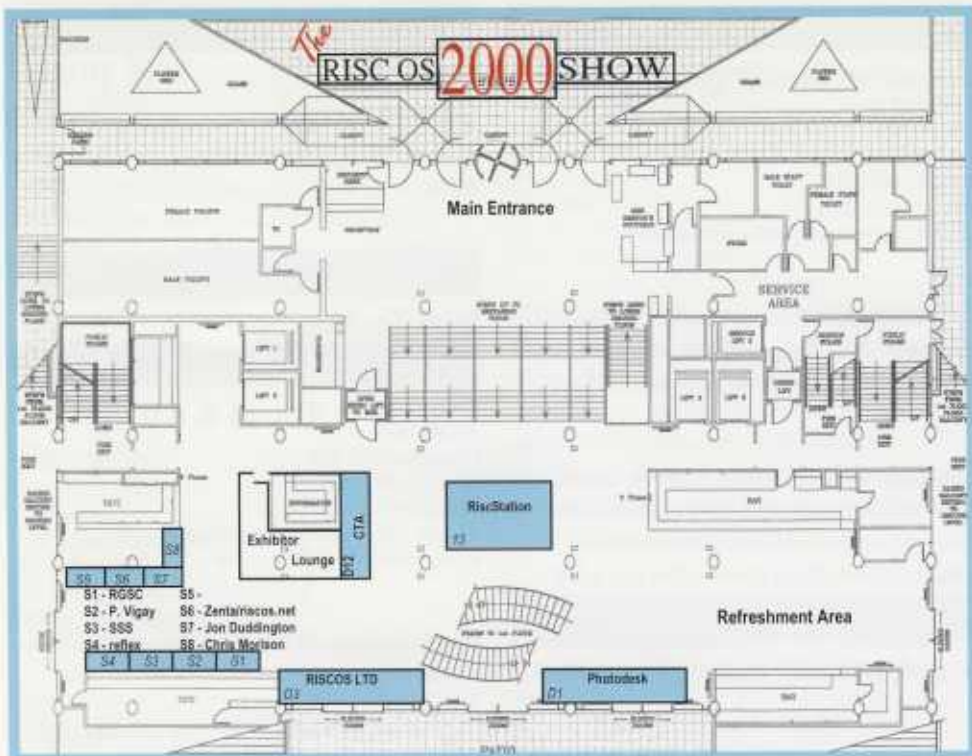

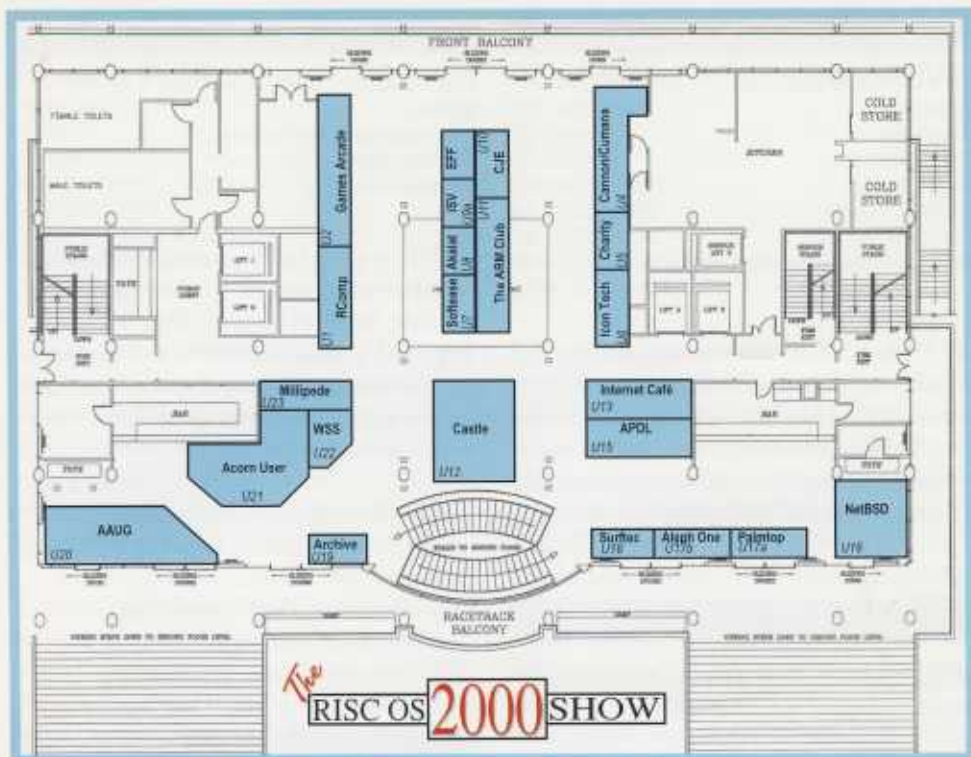
